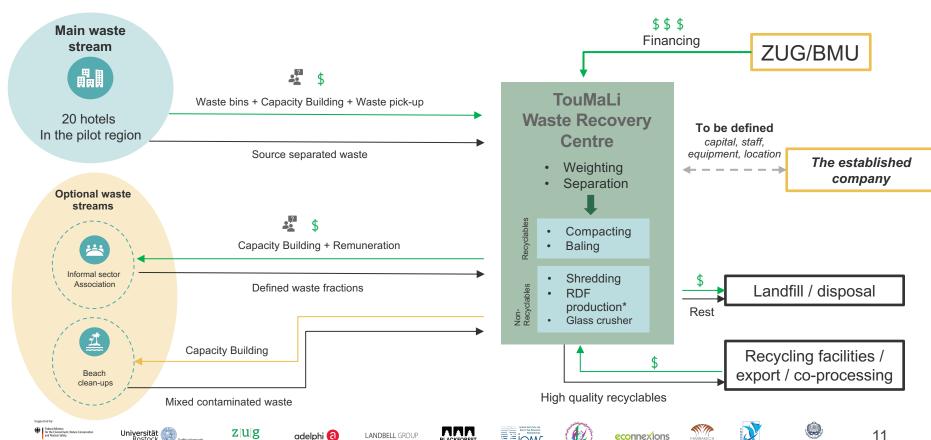

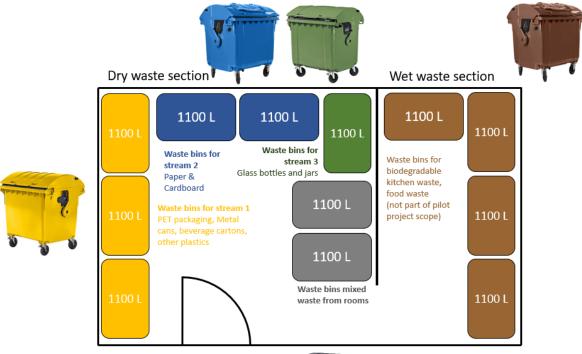






Waste bin arrangement scenario

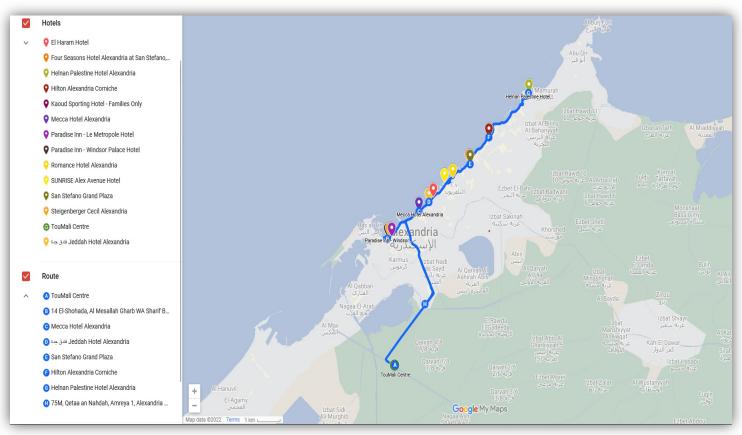

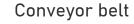

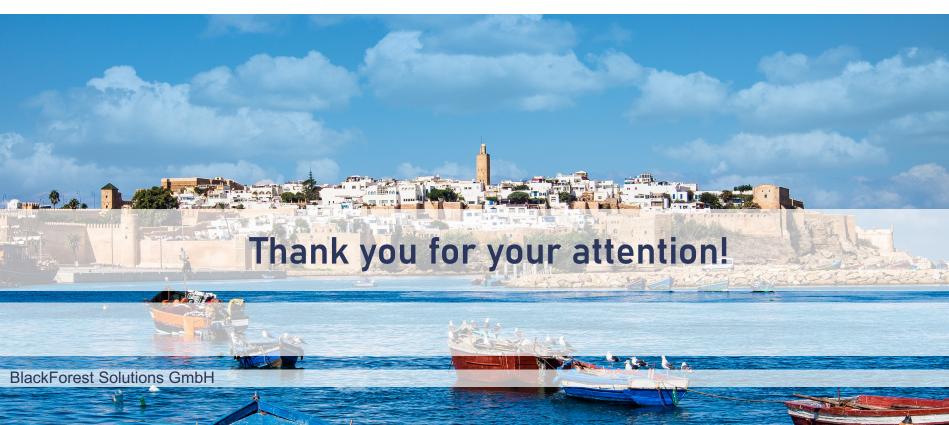












BFS' role within the project

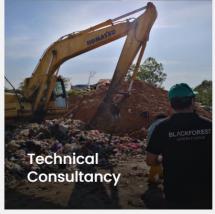
